## **1. WHO ARE WE?**

- 1.1. INFOSAÚDE - INSTITUTO DE FORMAÇÃO E INOVAÇÃO EM SAÚDE, S.A. (referred to “LEF”), with VAT number 505.215.330 and headquarters at Travessa de Santa Catarina, 8, 1200-403 Lisbon (Portugal) is the data controller regarding the processing of your personal data.

## **2. WHAT IS THIS POLICY ABOUT?**

- 2.1. This Policy explains how we collect and process personal data within:
- (a) the scope of the Website <https://medicalcannabiseurope.pt/> (referred to “Website”);
  - (b) the scope of all activities related with Medicinal Cannabis Europe Conference referred to “Conference”), namely, registration, organisation, management and execution; and
  - (c) the scope of further data processing purposes performed by LEF, namely to send LEF informative and marketing communications, in order to provide information on the activity of LEF.

## **3. WHAT ARE PERSONAL DATA?**

- 3.1. Personal data are any information (whatever its nature and media) which relates to a person, and which identifies that person.
- 3.2. The information that makes a person identifiable are also personal data.
- 3.3. An identifiable person is a person who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity.
- 3.4. Examples of personal data we collect are, among others, "name", "email", "phone number".

## **4. JOINT PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA.**

- 4.1. LEF will process personal data jointly with METRICALJOURNEY, LDA. (STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING), with NIPC 515.652.997 and registered office at Rua Aquilino Ribeiro, 26, 5300-087 Bragança (Portugal), on the scope of (i) the Website <https://medicalcannabiseurope.pt/>, and (ii) all activities related with Medicinal Cannabis Europe Conference referred to “Conference”), namely, registration, organisation, management and execution.

### **(a) JOINT PURPOSES FOR PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA**

LEF and STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING will be joint controllers for the processing of personal data for the following purposes:

<b>PURPOSE</b>	Organisation and management of “Medical Cannabis Europe Conference”
<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	To attend the Conference, LEF and STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING require personal data to register you for the Conference, to send you informative communications about the Conference and to enable us to better organise the resources needed for the Conference.

<b>PURPOSE</b>	Invoicing for Conference registration fees
<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	LEF and STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING require invoicing information, so we can invoice the Conference.

<b>PURPOSE</b>	Publish images and videos on LEF and STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING Websites and social networks, resulting from your participation in the Conference.
<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	If you authorise us, we will publish images and videos in our Websites and social media, in order to promote the Conference and gather more participants.

<b>PURPOSE</b>	Website management and maintenance
<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	LEF and STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING must ensure the security of the Website and must prevent fraud or misuse of the Website.

<b>PURPOSE</b>	Website optimisation and improvement
<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	If you authorise us, we will use personal data collected from cookies, to improve your experience, using our Website.

<b>PURPOSE</b>	Respond to your requests for information, complaints, comments or suggestions through <a href="mailto:info@medicalcannabiseurope.pt">info@medicalcannabiseurope.pt</a>

<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	If you send us an email through <a href="mailto:info@medicalcannabiseurope.pt">info@medicalcannabiseurope.pt</a> we will process personal data in order to respond to your request.

If LEF or STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING uses the personal data for purposes other than those indicated above, LEF or STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING will be considered for all purposes as an autonomous controller and shall comply with its obligations under data protection legislation.

(b) LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA:

The personal data processed by LEF and STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING, have specific legal basis according to the purposes for which they were collected:

<b>PURPOSE</b>	Organisation and management of “Medical Cannabis Europe Conference”.
<b>LEGAL BASIS</b>	Pre-contractual steps at the request of the data subject and based on the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party.

<b>PURPOSE</b>	Invoicing for Conference registration fees.
<b>LEGAL BASIS</b>	Legal obligations derived from commercial and tax legislation.

<b>PURPOSE</b>	Publish images and videos on LEF and STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING Websites and social networks, resulting from your participation in the Conference.
<b>LEGAL BASIS</b>	Consent

<b>PURPOSE</b>	Website management and maintenance
<b>LEGAL BASIS</b>	Legitimate interest
<b>DESCRIPTION OF LEGITIMATE INTEREST</b>	LEF and STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING must ensure that the Website operates securely and is not subject to malicious attacks. In case the Website is attacked, the LEF and STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING must ensure that the attack, minimally affect the Website, you, and your personal data.

<b>LEGAL BASIS</b>	Consent

<b>LEGAL BASIS</b>	Legitimate interest
<b>DESCRIPTION OF LEGITIMATE INTEREST</b>	LEF and STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING must ensure that all your questions are answered, your complaints are addressed, and your comments and suggestions are analysed.

(c) COMUNICACIONES TO THIRD PARTIES AND PROCESSORS:

LEF and STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING may use third parties (processors) to provide some services, such management of data centers, maintenance and technical support, Conference registration, Conference invoicing and Conference space provisioning, who may have access to some of the personal data, namely the data necessary for the contracted purposes.

We ensure that the entities which have access to your personal data are reliable and offer high levels of protection, never being transmitted personal data to those entities, beyond the necessary for the provision of the contracted service(s).

We may also transfer your data to the following entities:

- i. Companies of the business group to which LEF belongs and with which it has shared services or business partnerships for the creation and offer of benefits;
- ii. Companies of the business group to which STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING belongs and with which it has shared services or business partnerships for the creation and offer of benefits;
- iii. Legal representatives and courts, for the purpose of representation, declaration, exercise or defence of the rights in legal proceedings; and
- iv. Judicial authorities or criminal law enforcement agencies within the scope of judicial proceedings duly identified, in compliance with a reasoned order from the competent judicial authority.

LEF and STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING subcontracted the platform Eventbrite, managed by Eventbrite, Inc., for Conference registration and invoicing. Eventbrite, Inc. will collect personal data for the service but also for their own purposes, so we recommend reading Eventbrite Privacy Policy available at <https://www.eventbrite.pt/help/pt-pt/articles/460838/eventbrite-politica-de-privacidade/>.

(d) TRANSFERS OF PERSONAL DATA TO THIRD COUNTRIES:

LEF and STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING may carry out operations regarding personal data that coincide with their transfer to third countries to the European Union.

LEF and STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING ensure that all requirements set out in the GDPR are met, including (i) as to the adequacy of the country of destination, or (ii) as to the appropriate safeguards, or (i) on the existence of approved binding corporate rules, or (i) the existence and applicability of derogations for specific situations.

If the transfer takes place to countries without data protection rules similar to those in effect in the European Union, appropriate safeguards will be in place to protect your personal information, such as standard contractual clauses approved by the European Commission.

(e) DATA SUBJECTS EXERCISE OF RIGHTS:

The exercise of rights is made in accordance with Section 12, of this Policy.

The response to the request for the exercise of the rights is performed by LEF, but STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING is obliged to assist and collaborate with LEF in responding to those requests.

(f) PERSONAL DATA BREACH:

In the event of a personal data breach, LEF and STEPSCIENCE PHARMA ENGINEERING are obliged to assist and collaborate between them.

**5. AUTONOMOUS PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA.**

5.1. LEF will process personal data as an autonomous controller, on the scope of (i) further data processing purposes performed by LEF, namely to send LEF informative and marketing communications, in order to provide information on the activity of LEF.

(a) LEF PURPOSES FOR PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA

LEF will be an autonomous controller for the processing of personal data for the following purpose:

<b>PURPOSE</b>	Send LEF informative and marketing communications, in order to provide information on the activity of LEF.
<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	If you authorise us, we will send you communications about LEF's activity, in order to inform you about the work we do and about the services that we have.

LEF will not reuse the personal data for purposes other than those previously identified or those unrelated to those for which the personal data were originally collected.

(b) LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA:

The personal data processed by LEF, have specific legal basis according to the purposes for which they were collected:

<b>PURPOSE</b>	Send LEF informative and marketing communications, in order to provide information on the activity of LEF.
<b>LEGAL BASIS</b>	Consent

(c) COMUNICATIONS TO THIRD PARTIES AND PROCESSORS:

LEF may use third parties (processors) to provide some services, such management of data centers, maintenance and technical support and email marketing tools, who may have access to some of the personal data, namely the data necessary for the contracted purposes.

LEF ensures that the entities which have access to your personal data are reliable and offer high levels of protection, never being transmitted personal data to those entities, beyond the necessary for the provision of the contracted service(s).

LEF may also transfer your data to the following entities:

Companies of the business group to which LEF belongs and with which it has shared services or business partnerships for the creation and offer of benefits;

- v. Legal representatives and courts, for the purpose of representation, declaration, exercise or defence of the rights in legal proceedings; and
- vi. Judicial authorities or criminal law enforcement agencies within the scope of judicial proceedings duly identified, in compliance with a reasoned order from the competent judicial authority.

(d) TRANSFERS OF PERSONAL DATA TO THIRD COUNTRIES:

By default, and when LEF is an autonomous controller, no data transfers will occur outside the European Union Area.

If data transfers occur to third countries that do not belong to the European Union, namely, when necessary for the purpose of any services provided to LEF, will be complied with the legal rules, particularly with regard to the suitability of the destination country regarding the protection of personal data and requirements that are applicable to these transfers, not being transferred personal data to jurisdictions that do not offer guarantees of safety and protection.

(e) DATA SUBJECTS EXERCISE OF RIGHTS:

The exercise of rights is made in accordance with Section 12, of this Policy.

**6. WHAT PERSONAL DATA ARE COLLECTED?**

6.1. The following personal data, understood as minimal, necessary and adequate to the respective purposes, will be collected and processed:

## **7. HOW ARE YOUR PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED?**

7.1. Your personal data will be collected:

- (a) At the time you register for the Conference, through the Platforms that we may use for this purpose;
- (b) During the course of the Conference;
- (c) Through the Website itself and the communication and interaction it makes with your equipment, by cookies installed on your equipment;
- (d) Through an email that you may send us.

7.2. Your personal data is collected and processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner.

7.3. The use of the Website and the registration, organisation, management and execution of the Medical Cannabis Europe Conference activities are not directed to minors and the personal data of minors will not be intentionally processed.

## 8. WHAT ARE COOKIES, PIXEL TAGS AND OTHER SIMILAR TECHNOLOGIES?

- 8.1. Cookies, by definition, are small pieces of information, that collect and storage information on your equipment through your browser.
- 8.2. Cookies may be strictly necessary for the operation of the Website, for example, to:
- (a) Identify and authenticate the user; or
  - (b) Remember your usual preferences; or
  - (c) Allow you to complete tasks without having to re-enter information (e.g., when you change pages or return, as in the case of form data, shopping cart, etc); or
  - (d) Effect, enable, facilitate, or support communications from/through the Website; or
  - (e) Provide certain functionalities that you requested; or
  - (f) Information systems security and/or fraud prevention.
- 8.3. These cookies will be stored on your device and **do not require your consent**.
- 8.4. Cookies may also be used to collect information, for example to:
- (a) Measure and obtain statistics on the use of the Website, for example, number of unique visitors, detect keywords from search engines, detect specific aspects of browsing such as duration of visit, most visited pages or most accessed content (analytics cookies); or
  - (b) Tailor advertising and marketing based on your behaviour and profile by adapting the advertisements to be displayed (tracking cookies, advertising, analytics); or
  - (c) Third parties, other than Us, which collect your browsing information across different Websites in order to create such profiles (third party cookies).
- 8.5. The storage of these tracking, advertising, analytical and third-party cookies **will always depend on your prior acceptance and consent**, and this consent may be withdrawn at any time through specific tools and/or your browser.
- 8.6. Similarly, to cookies, there are tracking pixels, web beacons and other similar tools, which are images and/or pieces of code loaded when the user visits a Website, a page or content, but also, when opens an email.
- 8.7. These tools contain an external connection to a server of the tool and allow to track your behaviour, to obtain data for online marketing, analytics, but also, re-routing marketing.
- 8.8. When you visit the targeted Website, this operation is recorded in log files of the tool server and may include various information about the you, namely the operating system, session duration, or the IP address.
- 8.9. The storage of these tools **will always depend on your prior acceptance and consent**, and this consent may be withdrawn at any time through specific tools and/or your browser.

## 9. HOW ARE COOKIES, PIXEL TAGS AND OTHER SIMILAR TECHNOLOGIES USED?

- 9.1. The following table describes and explains how these tools are used:

9.2. You can withdraw consent at any time:

- (a) Through your browser settings, by disabling cookies and other tools; or
- (b) by using a blocking tool that can be used as an extension of your browser.

## 10. **HOW ARE YOUR PERSONAL DATA PROTECTED?**

- 10.1. Your personal data are kept secure by adopting various security measures of a technical and organisational nature which are intended to ensure the confidentiality, integrity and availability of the processing operations, for example by ensuring that the access to the processing operations occurs by authorised persons.
- 10.2. To protect your personal data, we only use data centre providers who offer appropriate security measures, in particular, guarantees that your personal data is stored on servers

which are maintained in controlled environments with limited access and which offer resilience guarantees.

- 10.3. Personal data is held on servers that offer adequate security guarantees to protect personal data against unauthorised disclosure, loss, misuse, alteration, processing or access, as well as any other form of unlawful processing.
- 10.4. Although we take the care and precautions we deem appropriate to protect the personal data you provide and we collect, you should be aware that no security system is completely impenetrable.
- 10.5. We remind you to take certain precautions when navigating and using the WEBSITE, namely when navigating public or shared networks.

## 11. **HOW LONG ARE YOUR DATA USED?**

- 11.1. Your personal data will be kept for as long as necessary for the purposes for which they are intended:

11.2. Where the law provides for a specific or mandatory period, the data will be kept for that period.

11.3 Notwithstanding, the periods indicated shall not prejudice the retention of personal data beyond those periods in the following situations:

- (a) as long as the retention period of any rights related to that purpose has not elapsed;
- (b) for the purpose of the declaration, exercise or defence of the rights in a lawsuit;
- (c) for as long as a judicial decision has not become final in any litigation related to this purpose;
- (d) for the fulfilment of new legal obligations to which we become subject;
- (e) for the fulfilment of orders from judicial authorities and/or criminal law enforcement agencies in the scope of judicial proceedings duly identified, in compliance with a reasoned order from the competent judicial authority; or
- (f) for the fulfilment of acts issued by administrative authorities and supervisory authorities within the scope of their competences.

11.3. In all other cases, the personal data will be kept for the retention period indicated above, which shall be sufficient for the fulfilment of the purposes indicated.

11.4. At the end of the retention period, all personal data collected will be deleted or anonymized.

## 12. **HOW CAN YOU EXERCISE YOUR RIGHTS?**

12.1. The legislation gives you the right to request us to exercise the following rights, which are exercised in accordance with and within the limits defined by the legislation:

<b>TO ACCESS</b>	You can confirm if your personal data is being processed and, if applicable, the right to access your personal data.
<b>TO RETIFICATION</b>	You have the right to request, at any time, the rectification of your personal data and also the right to have incomplete personal data completed.
<b>TO ERASURE</b>	You can request the erasure of your personal data when one of the reasons listed in the legislation applies.
<b>TO RESTRICTION</b>	You have the right to limit the processing of your personal data by HMR, if the one of the reasons listed in the legislation applies.
<b>TO OBJECT</b>	You have the right to object at any time to the processing of your personal data or to decisions based solely on automated processing, including profiling.
<b>TO PORTABILITY</b>	You have the right to receive your personal data and which you provided, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format
<b>TO WITHDRAW CONSENT</b>	You have the right to withdraw consent previously provided for some processing activities.

12.2. You have also the right to file a complaint with the supervisory authority (in Portugal, Comissão Nacional de Protecção de Dados, [www.cnpd.pt](http://www.cnpd.pt)).

- 12.3. To exercise your rights of access, rectification, erasure, objection and portability, you should contact us through [dpo@infosaude.pt](mailto:dpo@infosaude.pt).
- 12.4. To withdraw your consent, you can consult the Section 13.
- 12.5. If you request us to delete some or all of your personal data, we may keep only the personal data necessary to comply with our legal obligations.

### **13. HOW DO YOU WITHDRAW YOUR CONSENT?**

- 13.1. You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time and without any justification.
- 13.2.
